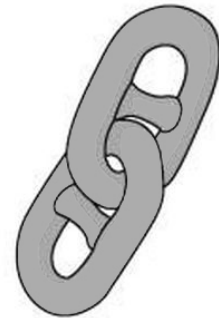

### ***Gravity Band***

A gravity band is often a shackle lower down the length of the shank which was used to help recover and stow the anchor alongside the vessel.

The gravity band is clearly visible on this anchor on display in Weymouth, Dorset, UK

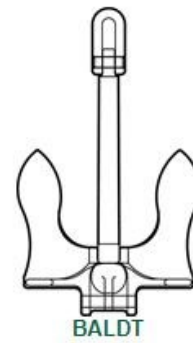
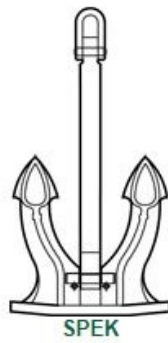
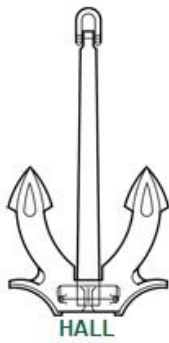
